Granted to John Kemberling bearing date the 19th day of March A.D. 1767. Resurveyed by the old lines and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land on the 7th day of December A.D. 1814 for and at the request of the owner Christian Hosler who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation.
