



By Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the 29<sup>th</sup>. day of June 1734 Survey'd unto Samuel Scott Scott the 22<sup>d</sup>. day of July then next Ensuing A piece or parcel of Land situate in Bradford in the County of Chester. — Beginning at a post being a corner of John Willis's land thence South 24<sup>d</sup>. East by the land of George Strode & Robt Jefferies Ninety Six Pches & a half to a Black Oak, Thence East North East by the Land of John Davies 155 Pches to a White Oak, thence North 24<sup>d</sup>. West by the sd. Scott's Land 66 Pches to a Hickory, Thence West by South by the Land of the sd. John Willis 158 Pches to the Place of Beginning Containing Seventy four Acres, and the Usual Allowance for Roads & Highways —

Returned into the Secretary's Office ye 29<sup>th</sup>. day of July Anno Dom 1734. — Take thy whole fees.
