



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Dated the seventh day of March 1733/4 Surveyed unto Robert Stapleton a Tract of Land Situate in Oley in the County of Philad^a. Beginning at a Black Oak a Corner of his other land thence by land of Sebastian Grieff South Seventy Degrees East two hundred and twenty perches to a Corner Stone thence by Vacant Land South Twenty Degrees West Seventy Seven perches to a Black Oak thence by Vacant Land North Seventy Degrees West two hundred and Twenty perches to a post thence by the said Robert Stapleton's other Land North twenty Degrees East Seventy Seven perches to the place of Beginning Containing one hundred acres with the usual allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent. Surveyed April 12th 1734.
