



By Order of the Proprietary Surveyed the 21st day of July Anno Dom 1738 to Alexander Scot a tract of Land Situate in the Township of Hempfield in the County of Lancaster Beginning at a White Oak in the line of Samuel Scot's Land thence South 9 deg. West 83 perches to a Beech Standing on the side of Sickasalunga Creek thence down the said Creek 40 perches to an ash thence South 25 deg. East 109 per. to a Gum thence South 62 deg. East 154 perches to a hickory thence North 56 perches to a post thence East North East 120 perches to a Black Oak thence North West by North 100 per to a hickory standing on the side of the afd.
