



By VIRTUE of a warrant from the Proprietaries Bearing Date the Seventeenth Day of May Anno Dom 1739 Surveyed to Hans-Adam Snider a tract of Land in the Township of Lebanon & County of Lancaster Beginning at a post a corner of Tybald Poffs Land thence by the said Land South by West 175 per. to a white oak thence South 44 deg. West 46 per. to a Lyn thence South 68 deg. East 28 per. to Maple thence South 36 deg. East 66 per. to a post thence North 49 deg. East 177 to a post thence North North West 196 per. to a post thence West 39 per. to a hickory thence South West by South 34 perches to the place of Beginning Containing One Hundred & Eighty Acres with the allowance of Six & Cent for Roads &c. Surv'd. May 24<sup>th</sup>. 1739.
