



By virtue of a Warrant from the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Proprietaries Bearing Date The 24<sup>th</sup> Day of July Anno Dom. 1740 Surveyed to Joseph Sherrock a Tract of Land in the Towns<sup>E</sup> of Hempfield Beginning at a Spanish Oak in the Line of Christian Honeman thence South 12 Deg. west 180 perches to a Hicory thence North 84 Deg East 129 pers. to a post thence North by East 78 per. to a Chesnut thence North North East 39 pers. to a Black Oak thence West North West 131 per. to the place of Beginning Containing One Hundred & Seven Acres of Land with the usual allowance of six acres & Cent for Roads &c.
