


By Order of the Proprietaries surveyed to Saml. Smith a Tract of Land Lyeing on Conewago Creek in Donegal & Derry Townships-Beginning at a pine tree standing on the sd. Creek thence South 56 1/4 Deg. East 273 perches to a Spanish Oak thence North 40-Deg. East 130 pers. to a white oak thence North 25-Deg. west 210 per. to a Black Oak thence South 74 Deg. West 123 perches to a post thence South west 92 perches to a post By the side of Conewago Creek thence Down the several Courses of the sd. Creek 70 perches to the place of Beginning. Containing Two Hundred ninety five acres with the usual allowance of six acres & Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed June the first Anno Dom. 1739.
