


Surveyed on the 13th of July 1737 to Martin Shankle a Tract of Lands situate in Oley in the County of Philada. Beginning at Black Oak Sapling a corner of Abraham Ashmans Land thence by Vac^t. Land S. 86 west 13 perches to a post a Corner of a tract of Land laid out to the Hon^{ble} Thomas Penn Esqr. thence by the same N.W. 101 perches to a post thence by the same S. 79 west 126 perches to a post thence by Vac^t. Land S. 18 E. 33 perches to a post thence by vac^t. Land S. 14 E. 30 perches to a Hickery a corner of a tract of Land laid out Casper Wister ^{thence} S. 61 East 180 perches to a post in a line of Abraham Ashmans Land thence by the same N. 18 E. 107 perches to the place of beginning Containing 118⁹⁵ with allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent.
