By VIRTUE of a warrant from the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Proprietaries bearing Date the 11<sup>th</sup> Day of March 9/1740

I have Survey'd and Laid out unto Daniel Slegle on Cortewaga Creek in the County of Lancaster on the West Side Susquehanna river. One hundred and thirty Six acres of Land with allow of six<sup>th</sup> Cent Beginning at a Chestnut oak Thence North Seventy Six Degrees Easterly one hundred & forty two<sup>th</sup>ches to a white oak Thence North Twenty three Degrees Easterly one hundred twenty Eight<sup>th</sup>ches To a white oak by the said Creek then up the same Traversing the Several Courses thereof near about Three hundred and Six perches to the place of Beginning
