


A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Erle Township in y<sup>e</sup> County of Lancaster containing two hundred and Eleven Acres and three quarters, and the usual allowance of six Acres & Cent for Roads &c<sup>s</sup> Surveyed to Jacob Sensiney by Warrant of the 27<sup>th</sup> of January 1734 who assigned his Right to 56<sup>ac</sup> thereof unto Michael Whitware. The Residue thereof viz<sup>t</sup> 155<sup>3/4</sup><sup>ac</sup> was Returned into the Secretary's Office the 26<sup>th</sup> day of November Anno Domini 1747 — and collected from the original Plans.
