



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Hon^{ble} the Proprietaries dated the 28th day of Aug^t 1738 Surveyed on the 25th day of May 1739 to John Ray the above described Tract of Land begin^g at a Black oak a Corner of Nicholas Depue's Land thence by the same N W 14 perches and the same Course by Vacant Land 168 perches to a Small Hick^{ry} thence by Vacant Land N E 207 perches to a Spanish oak thence by Vacant Land S E 87 perches and by Land of W^m Allen the same Course 78 Perches to a Black Oak on the River Delaware thence down the Same 215 Perches to the first mentioned Black Oak containing 208 Acres of Land and Allowance of Six P. Cent Situate on the River Delaware near Pehoquelin in the County of Bucks
