



A draft of a tract of land situate in Washington Township in the County of Franklin containing one hundred & twenty two acres 24 perches & the allowance of six P. Cent &c Surveyd 7th November 1800 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Philip Reed (joiner) bearing date 5th June 1800- The improvement on this tract together with one or two others were (unknown to the surveyor) included in a general survey of the Mountains in Washington Township made in the years 1792 & 1793 for John Holker Esqr who has not since come forward to get his surveys compleated his warrants bear date 6th Septemb^r 1792. The improvements on the above described tract are, several acres of land cleared 10 or 12 years ago, a number of bearing fruit trees, a small wooden spring house & the ruins of a cabbini.
