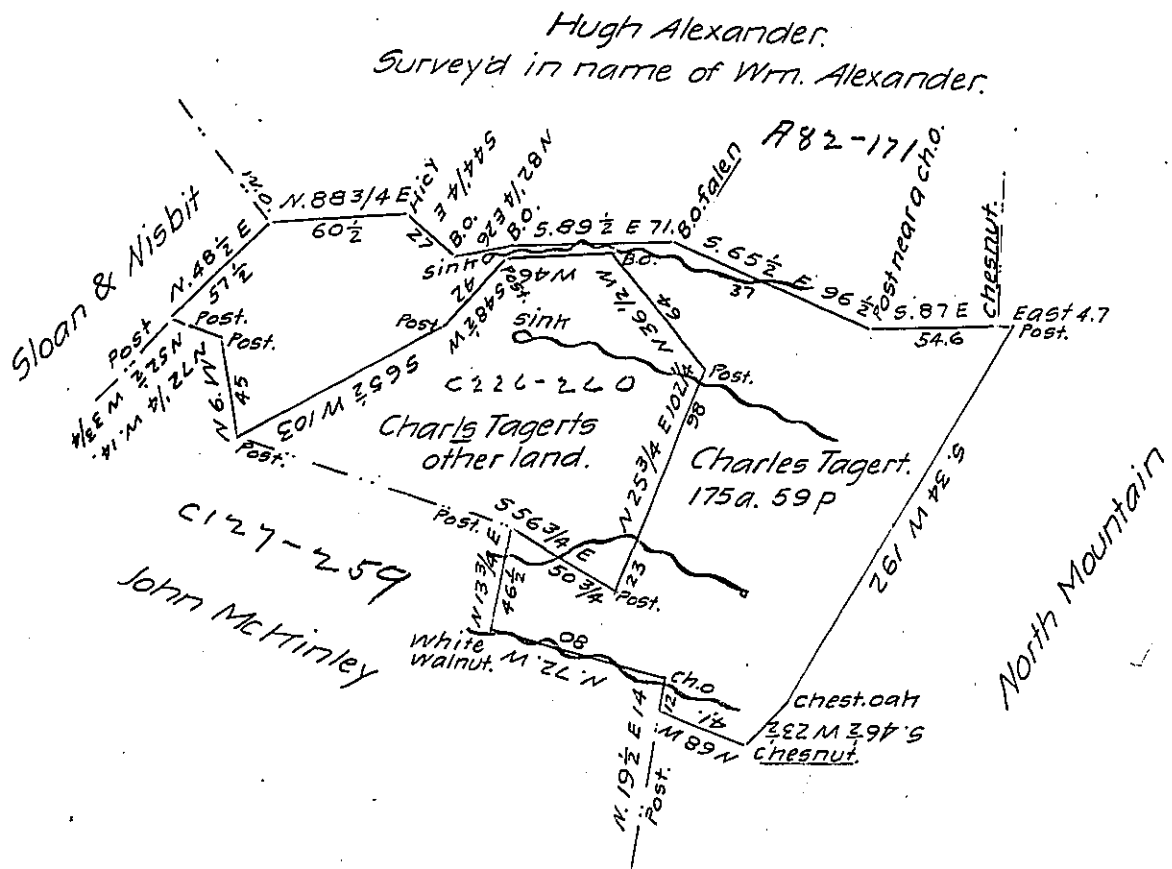

The survey'd for Charles Tagert the 31st day of December 1822 (by, or agreeable to, the marks of a resurvey formerly made by Geo. King) in pursuance of a warrant granted for surveying 160 acres dated feby 6th 1786. And now by order of the board dated March 24th 1819.

N.B. the tract of land lying between the first part of the line that from a. B. o bears S. 89 1/2 E. 71. and the line that from a. B. o runs west 46 to a post is patent land belonging to the above Charles Tagert being part of a Survey made in the year 1767 on application of Owen Owen.
