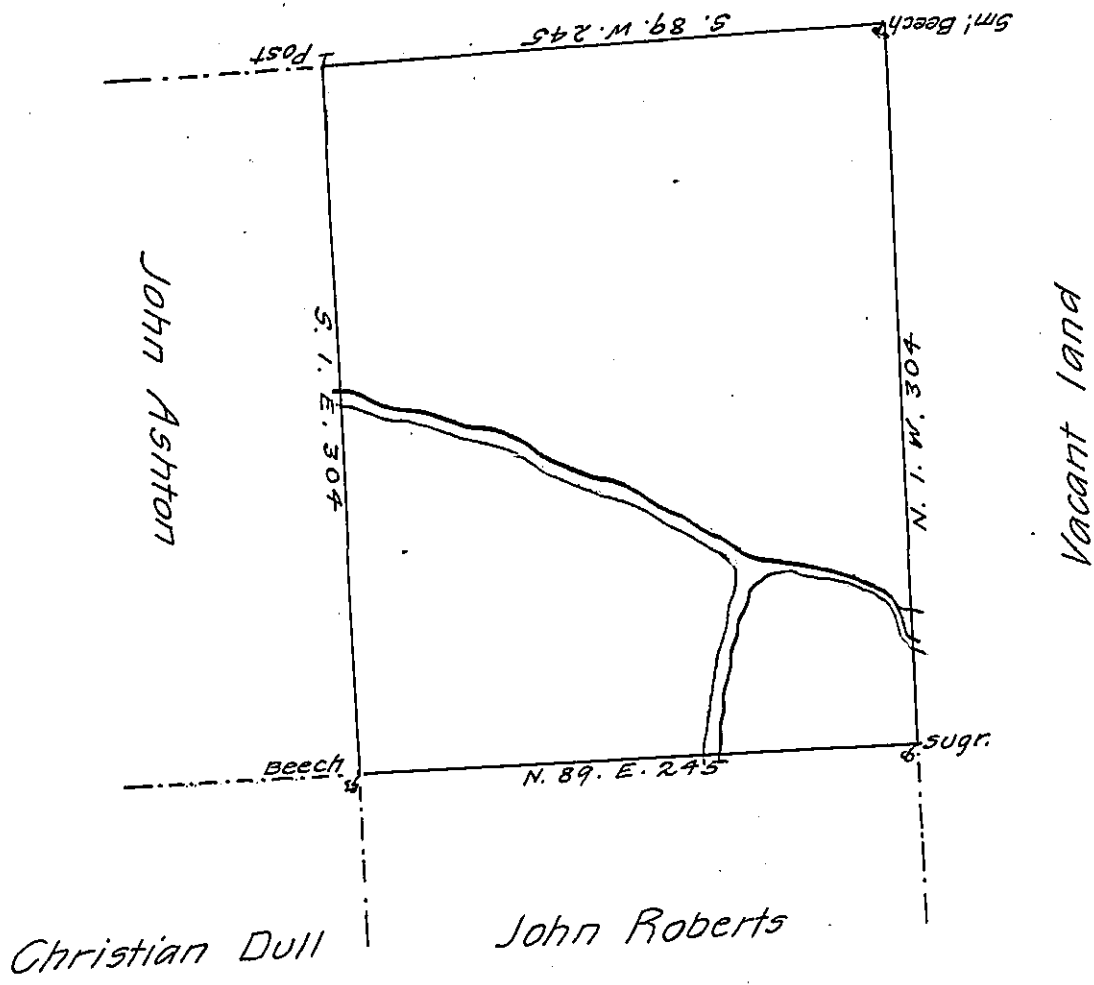


Vacant land
