November 1768 on an order of Survey granted to Benjamin Willits and Jacob Swiger dated 31st. May 1766 No 1586. The draft marked in yellow lines was Surveyed on a Warrant to Abraham Waggoner and patented containing 113 A. 18 pr. & allow. The part in red lines containing 67 Acres & allowance is part of Benjamin Willits and Jacob Swiger Surveyed & returned for patenting for Abraham Waggoner Nov. 5. 17th. 1837.
