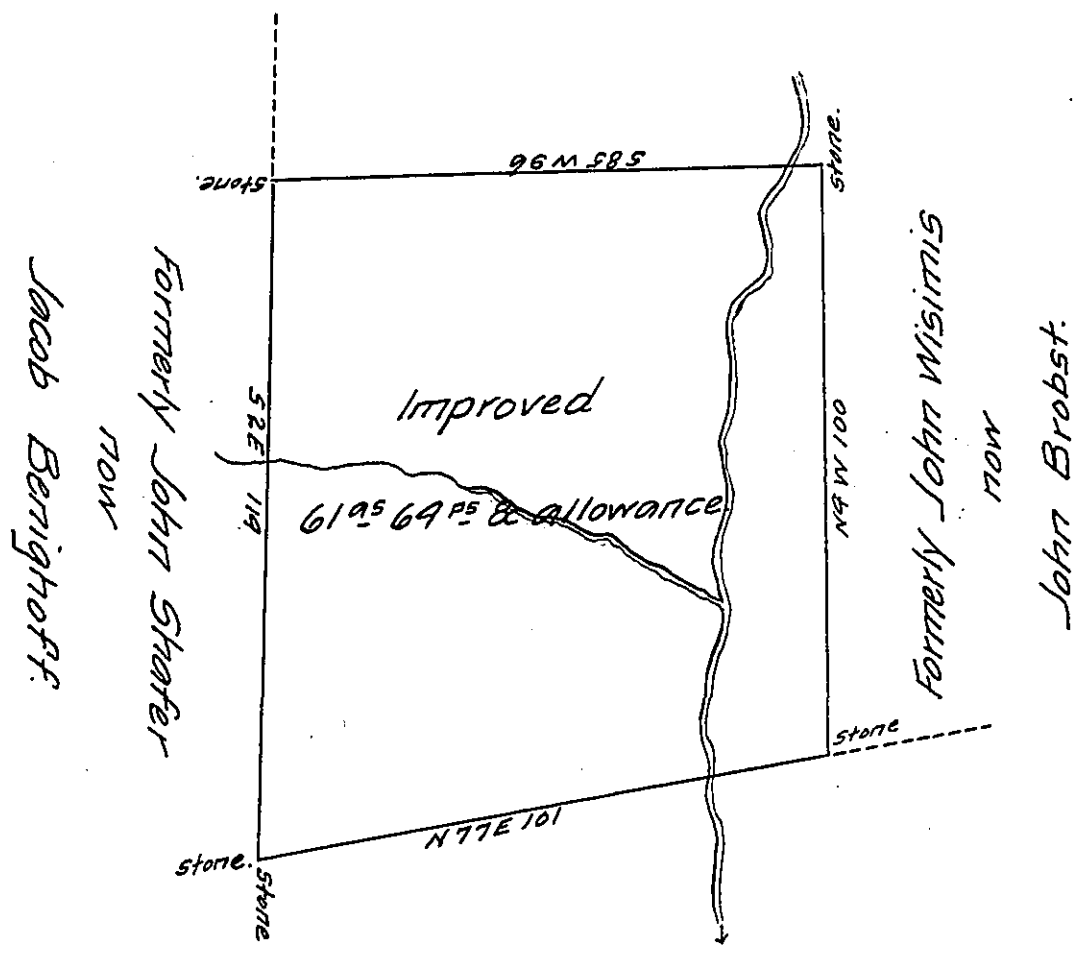


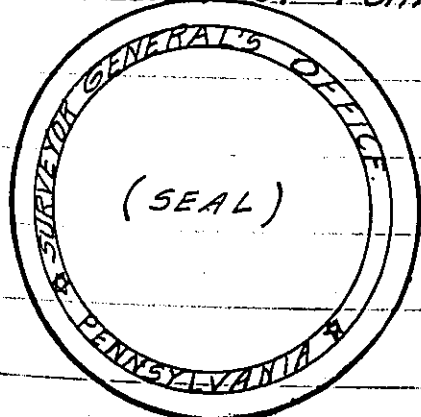

Situate in West Penn township Schuylkill County (formerly Penn Township Northampton County) containing sixty one acres and sixty four perches & allowance of 6 per ct. for roads &c. Being part of the same tract of land originally surveyed by virtue of an Application No. 3234, dated the 20th day of April 1768, by the Honorable Proprietaries & granted unto Andrew Foeller for 150 acres, adjoining John Shaffer & John Wisimis' land and the Blue Hills on Mahanoy Northampton County. Resurveyed and returned as the property of Samuel Zimmerman the 14th day of Feby. 1853.
