



The above draft describes a tract of land situate in Lower Oxford Township Chester County containing Five Acres and allowance of six Per Cent for roads &c. From the best information I can obtain from Mr. Churchman late a deputy Surveyor of Chester County (and from whom I am unable to obtain the Official papers of said county that are in his possession) the above Survey contains part of a tract of sixty four acres and allowance Surveyed to Thomas Wallace on his Warrant dated November 30th 1754.
