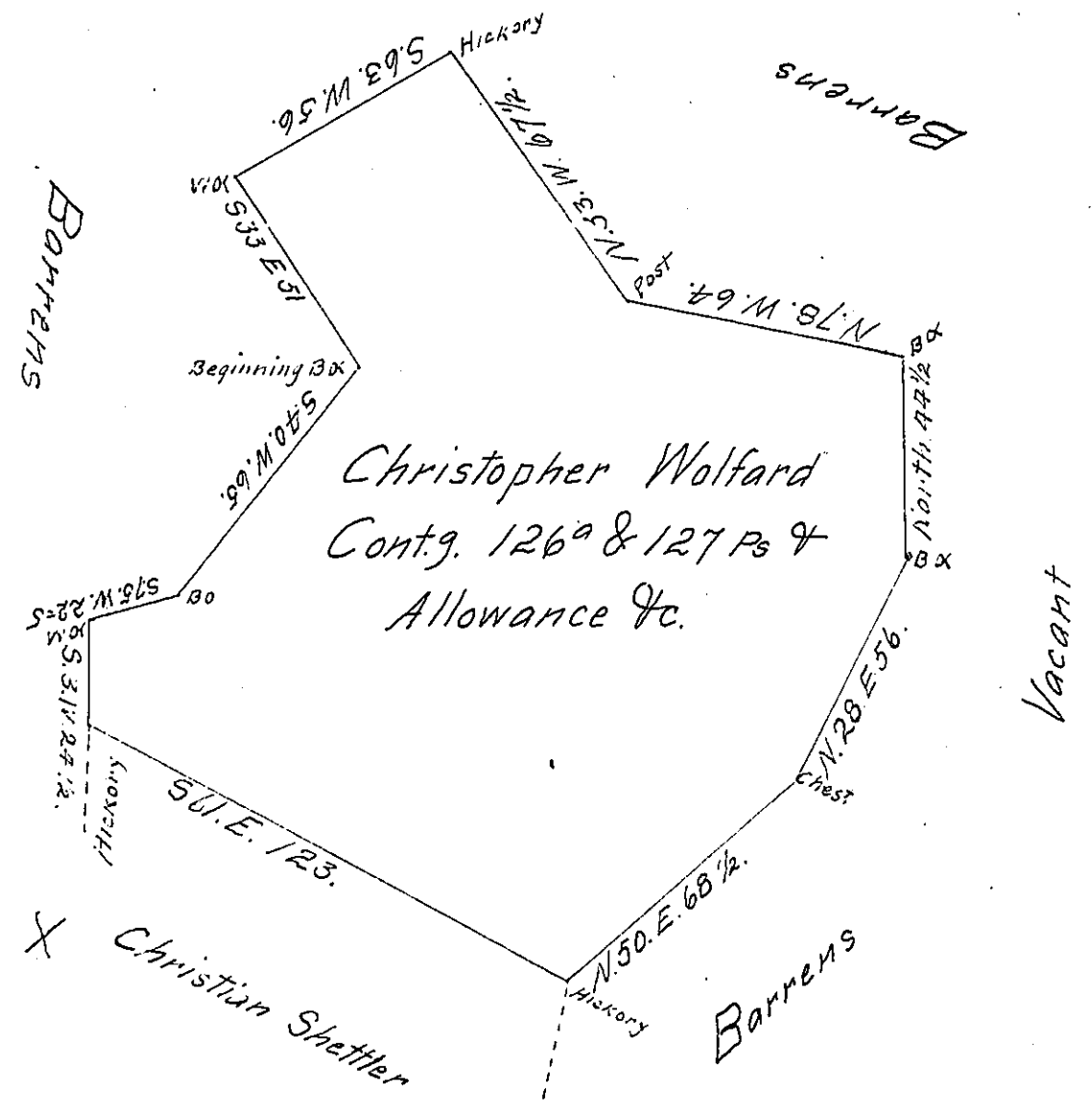


FORM NO 1.

Surveyed by William Mathews late D.S. on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of the 6<sup>th</sup> month 1767. for Christopher Wolfard. In pursuance of a Warrant for 150<sup>a</sup> Granted to him dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day of April 1767. And now at the request of the present owner John Hummen the above has been Calculated examined &c. and found to be correct. and at his request returned for Confirmation the 30<sup>th</sup> day of July Anno Domini 1811.
