



The above is a draft of a Survey executed Feby. 22<sup>nd</sup> 1814 in pursuance of a Warrant, granted to Valentine Welch, dated the 30<sup>th</sup> day of Decr 1813, Situate in North Sewickly Township Beaver County adjoining lands of Sampson Piersol Esqr Doct: B. Miller and others Containing 400 Acres & allowance of Six per Cent.

At the time of executing the above survey the Sd Valentine Welch was actually residing thereon with his family, there was a house erected thereon fit for the habitation of man, & there were at least forty acres of the Sd land Cleared fenced & Cultivated.
