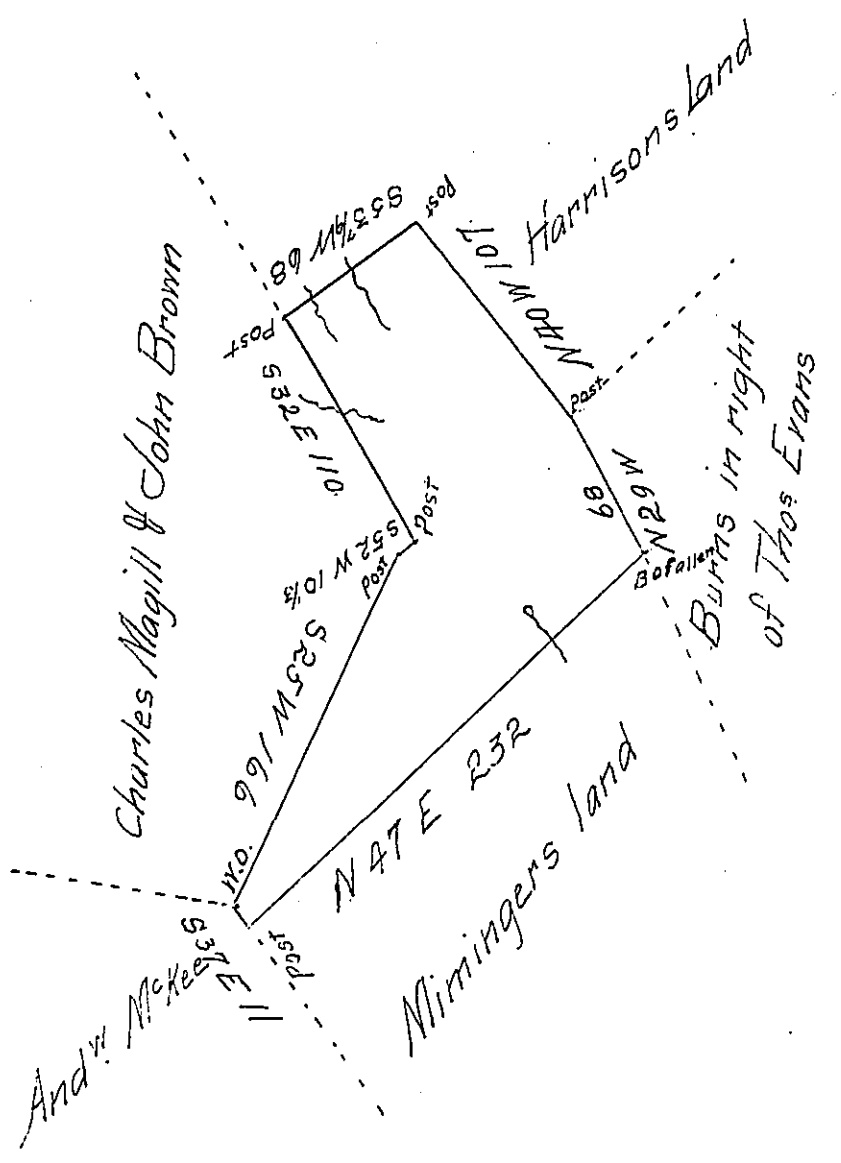


FORM NO. 1.



A draught of one hundred and twenty one acres and seventy four perches of land with six per Cent for Roads Situate in Derry township in Mifflin county surveyed 22nd November 1813 in pursuance of a Warrant to Michael Rits dated Sixth October 1813. Note there was a family residing on the above land at the time of survey, and at least twelve acres thereof in a state of Cultivation —
