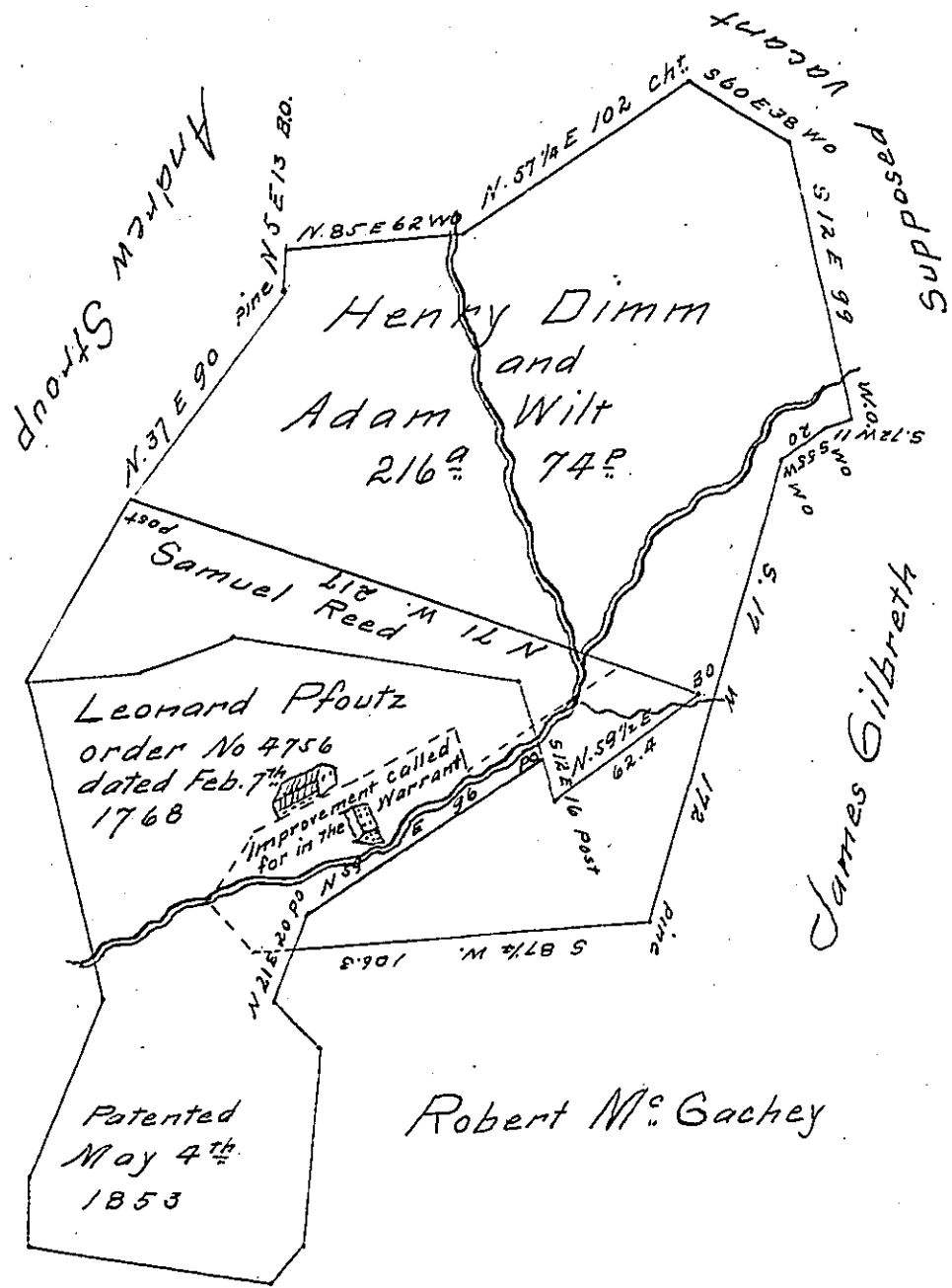

Draft of a tract of land containing one hundred and sixteen acres, and seventy-four perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c, situated in Greenwood Township in the County of Juniata surveyed the 21<sup>st</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> days of August 1818, in pursuance of a warrant granted to Henry Dimm and Adam Wilt, dated the 5<sup>th</sup> day of September 1815 Resurveyed (in pursuance of an Order of Re-survey granted October 12<sup>th</sup> 1870 by the Board of Property to exclude interferences.)
