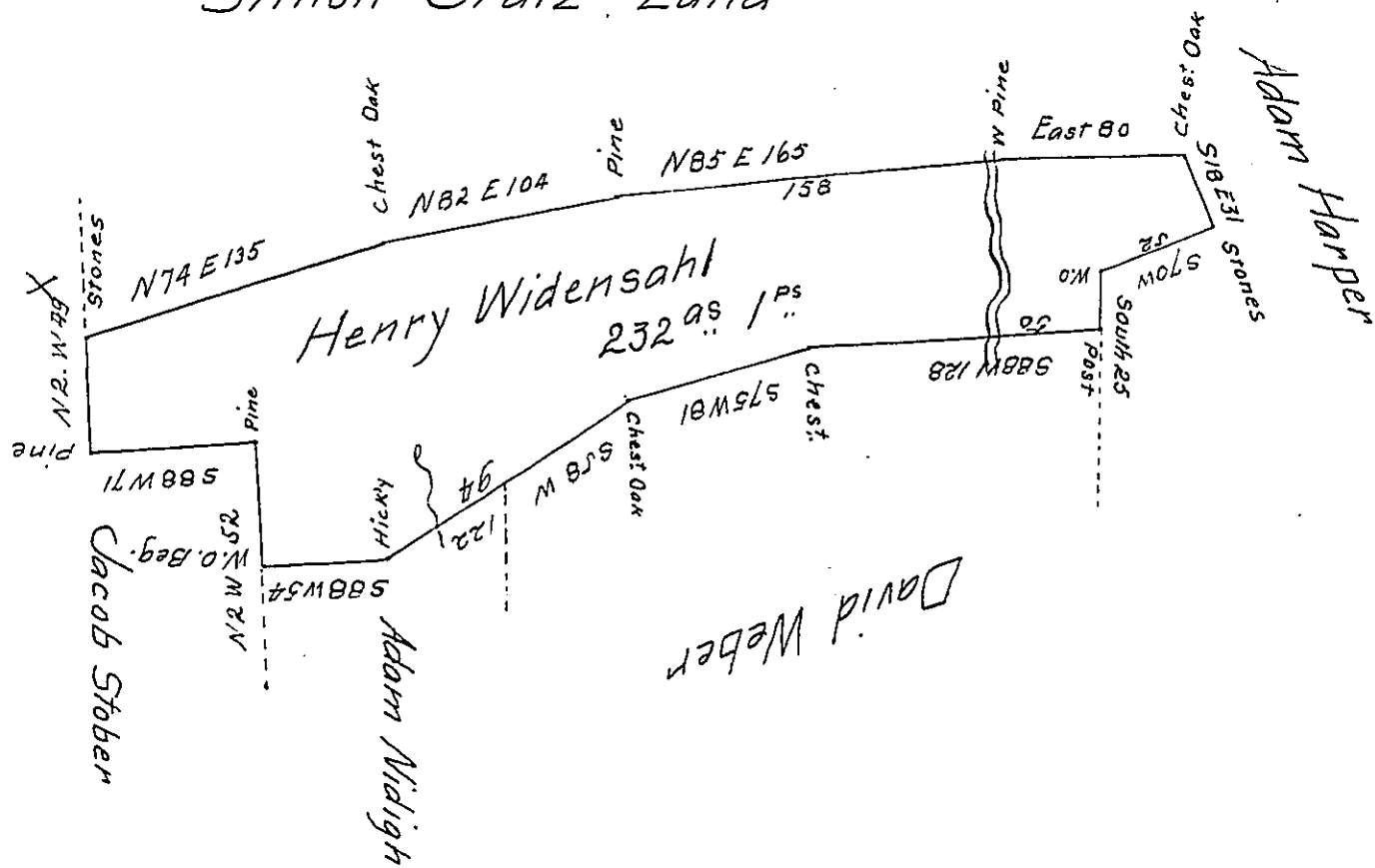


Brush-valley Mountain

Simon Gratz's Land



The Draught of a tract of Land Situate in Hains Township Centre County Containing two hundred and thirty two Acres, one perch and Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 28th day of May 1812, in pursuance of a warrant Granted to Henry Widensahl dated the 17th day of January 1812.

On the above described tract of Land, there is a square Log dwelling house occupied by the above named Henry Widensahl and his family, a stable, and about eight or nine Acres of Clear land, and agreeable to the best information I could obtain it was first Improved in October 1797.
