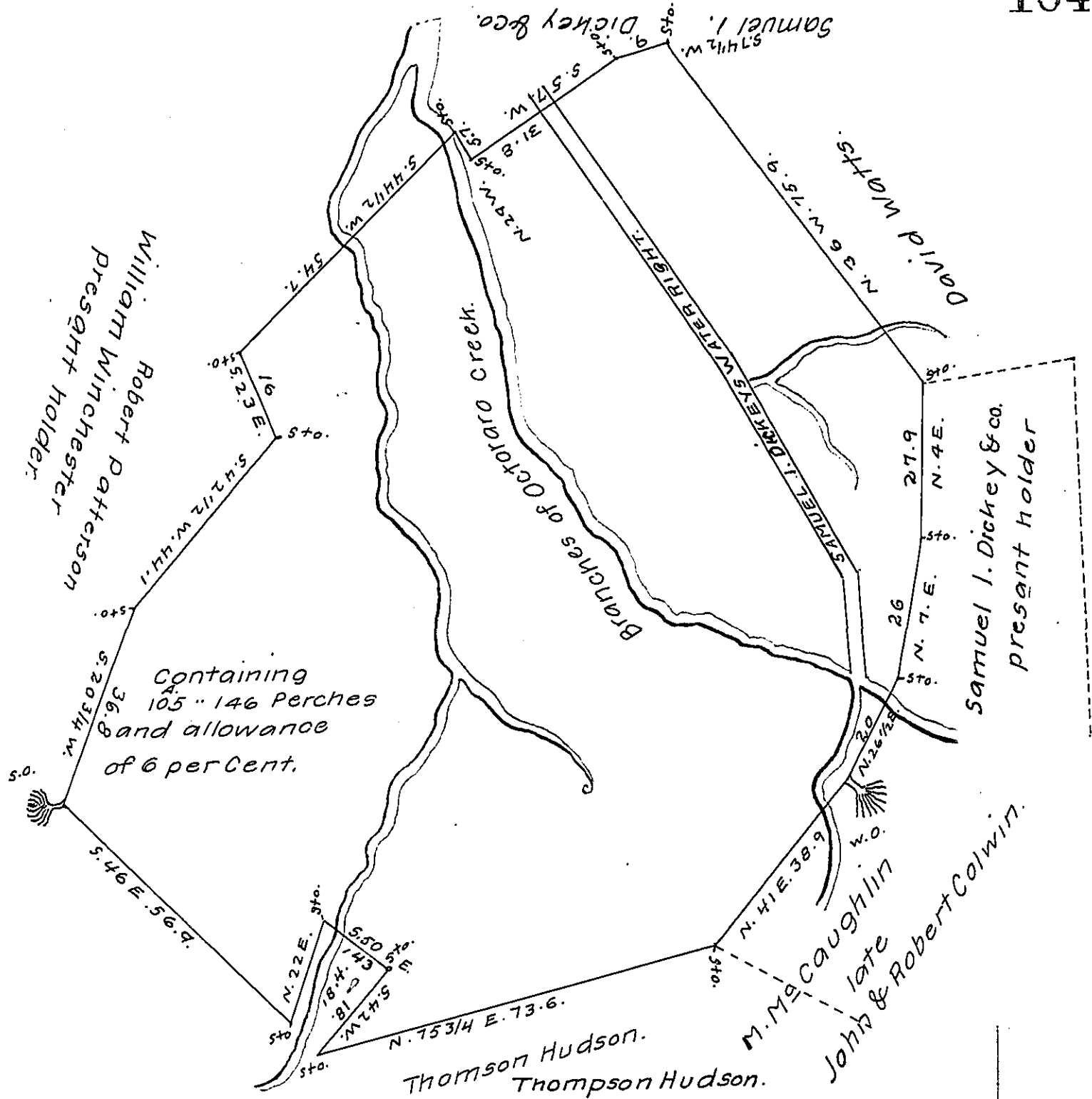

Situate part in East Nottingham and part in Lower Oxford Townships in the County of Chester Exhibit a Tract of Land Surveyed for a Certain James Patterson in Pursuance of three Warrants, 1st Baring date 19th February, 1741 and No 2 Baring date 19th August, 1746 and 3th Baring date 20th March 1753 all the Warrants Granted to said James Patterson Containing in all 138 acres and allowance and survey Returned for the Same in the year 1772 - the above survey of 105.146 and allowance being part of the 3 above mentioned Warrants and survey of 138 acres as above stated Now the Property of Nathaniel P.
