



The above Draught represents a tract of land situate part in Upper Oxford & part in West Fallowfield township Chester County containing one hundred and sixty nine acres & one hundred and four perches & allowance of Six per Cent. for Roads &c<sup>a</sup>. A survey thereof sign'd Charles Dilworth then Deputy Surveyor dated March 1788 appears to have been regularly made to Joseph Robb on his Warrant dated the 4th. of March 1788 a copy of which Survey together with a draught &c. was put into my hands by said Robb, and having examined the same, am of opinion it may be depended upon
