



The above Draught represents a Tract of Land situate in East Nottingham & New London Townships Chester County containing <sup>as.</sup> 75<sup>as.</sup> 148<sup>ps</sup> & allowance of six per cent. &c. Being a part of a Tract of Land which was Resurveyed for Moses Ross the 19<sup>th</sup>. 12<sup>mo</sup>. 1755 including a Tract formerly surveyed & Returned for John Crawford which was vacated and the right vested in Moses Ross the whole contains 308<sup>as.</sup> & allowance of six per cent. 100<sup>as.</sup> whereof was surveyed for Gilbert Buchanan by Warrant of the 2<sup>d</sup>. of May 1753 & the other 208<sup>as.</sup> Resurveyed to Moses Ross aforesaid by warrant of the 13<sup>th</sup>. of August 1755. the whole directed by him & his relation the said Gilbert to be returned in one Draught. Surveyed March 8<sup>th</sup>. 1821.
