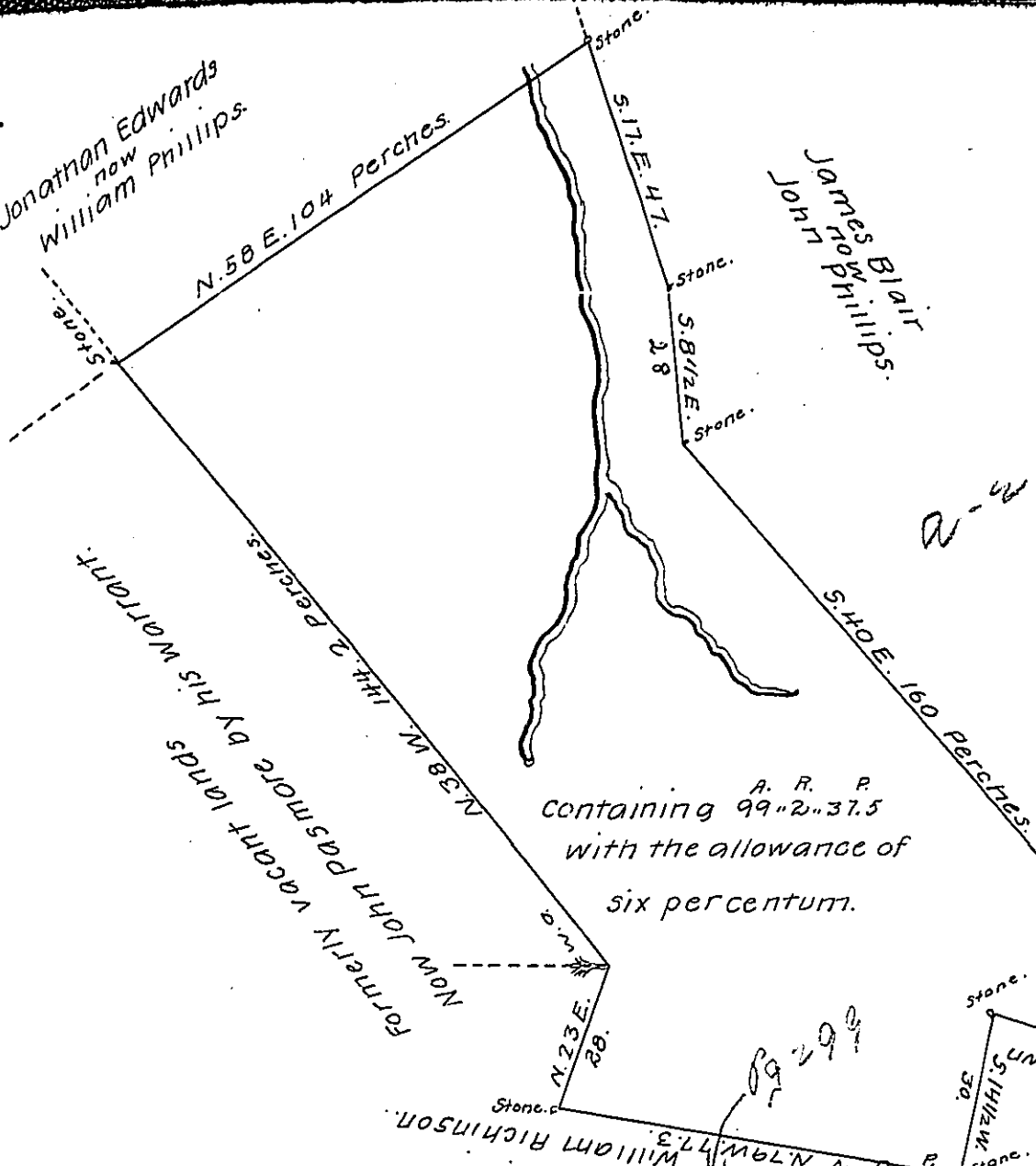

Situate partly in the Pine Barrens in West Nottingham Township in the County of Chester Being the Same Tract of Land Granted to John Hamilton of said County by Warrant Baring date the 20th. day of July 1744 for one Hundred Acres of Land, said land has been Improved by estimation for upwards of sixty years past, the several adjoiners as above stated which I believe to be correct said Tract of Land is now in the Actual Possession of Thomas Phillips who has been the holder for the last Thirty years past, The above being surveyed by me the 4th. day of February A.D. 1841.
