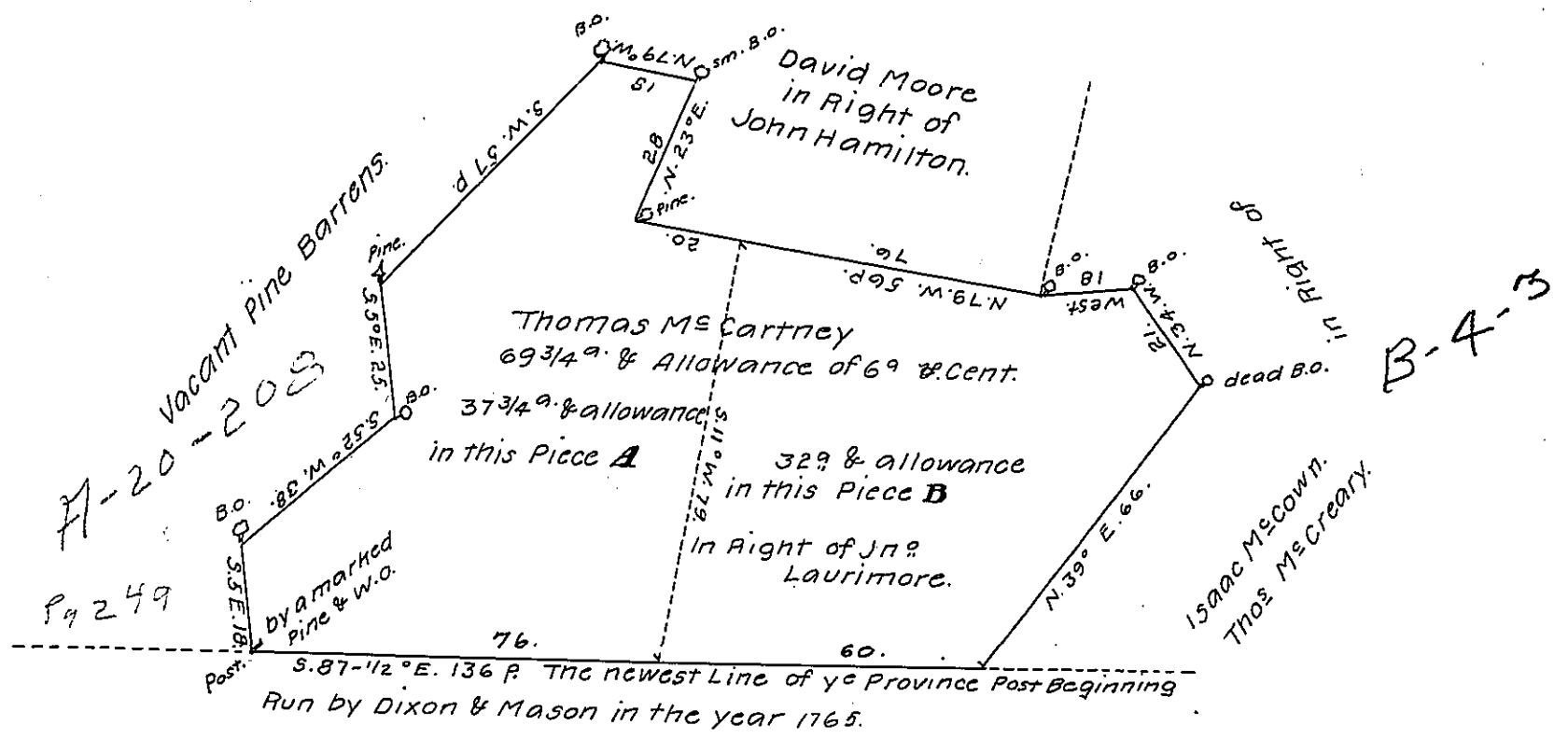

 Warrant granted to Jn<sup>o</sup> Laurimore bearing Date the 21<sup>st</sup> Decem<sup>r</sup> 1748. by G. C. &  
 37<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> a. & allowance of 6 p<sup>er</sup> Cent, at A was survey'd for Tho<sup>s</sup> M<sup>c</sup>Cartney in the 10<sup>th</sup>  
 mo. last, upon his Application; In Pursuance of an Order for that Purpose Issu-  
 ed from the Land Office, & directed to Lightfoot & Parvin bearing Date the 5<sup>th</sup>  
 of August 1765; Survey'd & Certify'd at their Request & on their Behalf By  
 3 mo. 14<sup>th</sup>. 1766. Geo. Churchman.
