



The above described tract was Surveyed to Thomas McArthur on the 30th of October 1784 By warrant of the 23d of August 1784 and is the same tract upon which a Survey has been made for Robert Culbertson on the 2d day of May 1828 A return whereof is herewith enclosed From the description of the location and the last information I could obtain ^{I am} inclined to think the Location must have been intended for the above land It does not appear that any survey has ever been made upon ^{the} above or elsewhere in pursuance of the said Location until the present - The ^{said} tract of land is owned & occupied by Robert Elder who claims under the title to Thomas McArthur
