



The above described tract was Surveyed to Thomas McArthur on the 30th of October 1784 By warrant of the 23d of August 1784 and is the same tract which upon a Survey has been made for Robert Culbertson on the 2d day of May 1828 A return whereof is herewith enclosed From the description of the Location and the last information I could obtain I <sup>am</sup> inclined to think the Location must have been intended for the above land. It does not appear that any survey has ever been made upon <sup>the</sup> above or elsewhere in pursuance of the said Location until the present - The <sup>said</sup> tract of land is owned & occupied by Robert Elder who claims under the title to Thomas McArthur.
