

Situate in White Deer township Union (late Berks) County Surveyed the 31st day of August 1832 by virtue of an order of Survey granted to Frederic Kneible dated the 3d day of April 1769 Nº1727 Containing three hundred and twenty Acres with the usual Allowance &c.

Note: The same tract of land was Surveyed the 2d day of June 1794 for Will-land Armstrong in pursuance of his order dated the 3d day of Ápril 1769 Nº
