Note The same tract of land was surveyed the 10th day of June A.D. 1770 in pursuance of order of Survey Granted to Charles Barkman Dated the 19th day of August 1769 N<sup>o</sup> 3740 and now owned By the Heirs of Andrew Rudy &c others in right of the said Charles Barkman
