

The above tract NºI was surveyed and returned on a Warrant granted to Henry Brinker bearing date of November 4th 1772

Nº 2 was surveyed and returned on a warrant dated November 18th

P.S. William Ferguson owned the above lands and had a Location for them but when he conveyed to the Brinkers he would not give up the location being of a wrangling disposition and they had to take out warrants and patent on them - he lived on the part N°1. but both these were afterwards surveyed on the warrants on the strength of his title and improvement.
