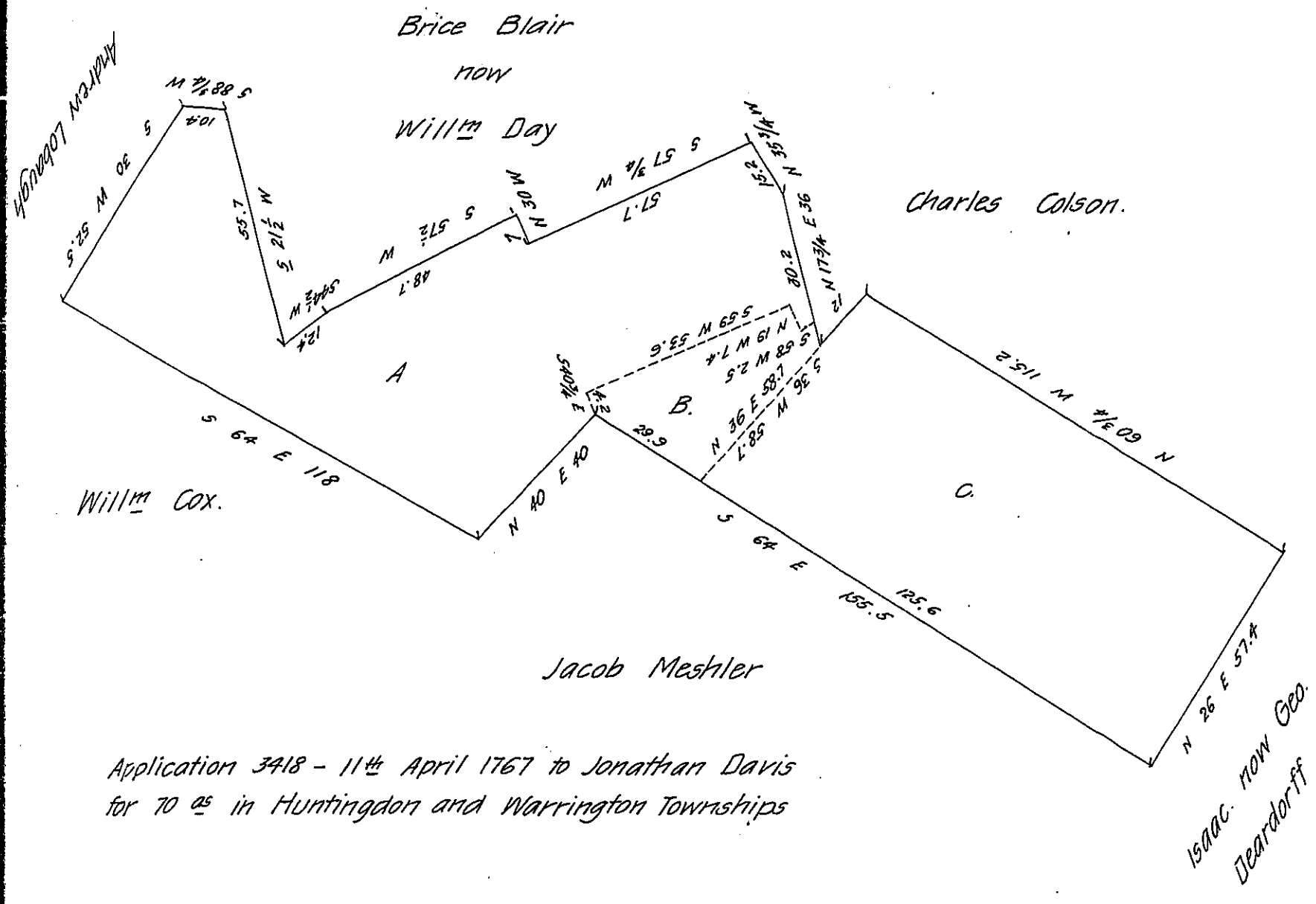

Application 3418 - 11<sup>th</sup> April 1767 to Jonathan Davis  
for 70<sup>ac</sup> in Huntingdon and Warrington Townships

The Parts marked A and B are Interferences of a Tract of Land  
Surveyed on Warr<sup>t</sup> dated March 10<sup>th</sup> 1742 to Brice Blair. Part A containing  
47<sup>ac</sup> 117<sup>p</sup> and all<sup>ce</sup> is now owned by Sylvanus Day - Part B. being part of a  
larger Tract is now owned by Gabriel Jacobs, Margaret Shultz & George Pott. - Part C.  
is an Interference of a tract of 40<sup>ac</sup> 130<sup>p</sup> & all<sup>ce</sup> Surveyed on Warr<sup>t</sup> dated June  
1<sup>st</sup> 1762 to Richard McCallister now owned by Daniel Hoopert - The whole of the  
above is situate in Huntingdon Township Adams County.
