


FORM NO 1.



Draft of a Tract of land situate in Montgomery township (formerly Peters township) Franklin County Containing sixty eight acres twenty six perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c surveyed the 9<sup>th</sup> of April 1829 in pursuance of a Contract with the Board of property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to proprietary rights & on an application granted Samuel McMicken for 50<sup>ac</sup> of land Bounded by William Sample William Campbell & James Wilson in Peters township dated the 8<sup>th</sup> of April 1767 No 3383.

The land above described is included in a survey containing 228<sup>ac</sup> 54 per & all which was surveyed on a warrant granted Archibald Scott dated the 28<sup>th</sup> of October 1786 under which the present owner claims there is no evidence of any survey having been made on McMickens Application.
