Report - The above Tract is covered in part by a Survey of 409 A^s 100^p on a Warrant to David Ross dated 7 March 1794. - Also covered the residue by a Survey of 400 1/2 acres on a Warrant - Mary Black dated 7 March 1794. - Note See a Warrant for 400 Acres granted to William Richardson dated 13 Feb^y 1796 intended to cover the above land; but no Survey found thereon - Richardson once owned the land. -

Note - The above Survey is rather superficial; not being able to ascertain the boundary of the present claimant of the land. - The lines were only extended to cover the Improvement with a reasonable portion of Timber.

Note - The above is the Land or part of the Land bought by Spear from Herram (from information) - The present owner claims 300 A^s here on Improvement.
