N.B. Part of the James Ralph Survey is held by Virtue of an Improvement made in 1788 by George Pickett who conveyed to Alexander Rheim - who conveyed to Eli Leidig from whom it was sold by the Sherriff of Bedford County to Cornelous Devore the present Owner.
