

A draught of a tract of land situate in Warrington Township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 134.9 150 ps. and allowances &c Surveyed on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of December A.D. 1832 in pursuance of the Application No 3001 Granted to Benjamin Underwood for 100<sup>9</sup> dated the 5<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1767 &c the land above represented is now claimed by Abraham Wells and John Walker Abraham Wells would not show his writings says some person lost the old titles &c long ago John Walker said he could not find his draughts or titles &c but it appears to be the same land which was surveyed for Benjamin Walker in pursuance of a warrant granted to him dated the 26<sup>th</sup> May 1788
