



In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the Principal and Interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding lands by virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government & for other Purposes, I have this day located and surveyed Applicaⁿ 3652 - granted 8th May 1767 to John Galbraith for 100 ^{as} joining as above specified in Menallen Township on lands situate as aforesaid in Menallen Township and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram.
