

No 2 represents part of a survey made for John Cannon on an improvement made
about 30 years ago. This survey interferes three acres and one hundred and
forty two perches with the James Hughes tract. John Cannon conveyed to Benjamin
R. Morgan who is the present owner.

No 1. represents part of a survey made for James Dunlap on Warrant dated
the 15th day of January 1794 - This survey interferes thirty nine acres and
twenty seven perches with the James Hughes tract. James Dunlap conveyed to
John Cannon who conveyed to Benjamin R. Morgan the present owner.

No 3. represents part of a survey made for Henry Cannon on Warrant dated
the 25th Feby 1794

This survey interferes seventy seven acres with the James Hughes
tract. Henry Cannon conveyed to John Cannon who conveyed to Joseph
Shaw.

conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of
