In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the Principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other Purposes I have this day located and surveyed Application 2720 granted 6th feby 1767 to Peter Meen for 30^{as} near Cornwago Creek on Lands situate as aforesaid in Cornwago Township Adams County and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram
