



In pursuance of an application granted to James Carr No. 1687 and dated 3<sup>rd</sup> of April 1769 Surveyed the above described tract of Land on the 29th of September 1828 Containing two hundred and ninety five acres and thirty perches and the allowance proportioned at six per cent. for roads &c Situate on the waters of ~~the~~ M'Gees Run near the foot of Chesnut Ridge in Derry Township Westmoreland County.

(Note) the above land was warranted to Wm. Searight who conveyed the same to James Wilson to whom a patent was granted dated 9<sup>th</sup> of October 1795 and enrolled in Patent Book N<sup>o</sup>. 27 page 139
