



A draft of a tract of land situate on Stells Run a Branch of Durrings Creek in the Township & County of Bedford Containing One hundred and twelve acres & thirty five perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed for Alexander Steell on Order No 3583 dated the 2nd day of May 1767.

NB the green lines represent a draft of a tract of land surveyed for Jacob Saylor the 26th day of July 1786 on Warrant dated the 13th day of September 1785 - this Survey interferes One hundred & twelve Acres & thirty five perches with the Andrew Steell tract. Andrew Steell conveyed to Jacob Saylor who obtained the above recited Warrant & conveyed to Adam Shurich from whom the same was sold by the Sheriff of Bedford County to John Heltzell the present owner.
