 North East 500 perches by a Line of marked trees to another
 post Sett in the ground hard by a w^t oke marked from thenc by
 a Line of marked trees North West 96 perches to a Corner Stake deviding
 it from Joseph Taners Land from thenc by a line of marked trees
 South West 500 perches to another Corner post deviding it from
 Joseph Taners Land from thenc by a Line of maked trees
 South East 96 perches to the place of be gineing Containeing and
 Laid out for three hundred acers of Land the 21st & 2^d mo 1701
