At ye Request of Thomas Barker Purchaser of One Thousand Acres of Land yt I would grant him to take up Four hundred Acres in any of ye Counties of this Province. These are to will and require thee forthwth to Survey or cause to be Surveyd unto him yesd Number of Acres in what County he Shall be willing to take it up in a place not already taken up according to ye methods of Townships appointed by me and make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office.

Given at Philadelphia ye 28th M^o 1683.
