five hundred - in part thereof in the County of Bucks. These are  
therefore in the Proprietary's Name to will & require thee forthwith  
to Survey or cause to be Survey'd unto him the Said Number of Acres  
in ye aforesd County, where not already taken up according to ye  
Method of Township appoynted by the Govern'r he seating &  
Improving the Same within Six Moneths from ye date of Survey  
and make returns thereof into the Govern'r's Secretary's Office.
