



At the Request of John Burgess & Roger Moon Resurveyed and Divided a tract of Land in Falls Township formerly belonging to James Hill. The 5^d John Burgess part beginning at a Post at John Clark's Corner, from thence Extending by the 5^d Clark's & Daniel Burgess Land West five hundred Sixty two perches to a Poplar tree, Then North by Joseph Kirkbride's Land Eighty eight perches to a Post, Then East by the 5^d Roger Moon's Line three hundred & ninety perches to a Post in a Meadow, Then by the 5^d Moon's Land East South East One hundred & Six perches to a Post, Then againe by the 5^d Moon's Land North North East forty perches to a Maple tree in Samuel Dark's Line, Then by the 5^d Line East South East ^{forty eight perches} to a Small White oak, Then by Robert Harvy's Land South South East Seventy two Perches to the place of beginning Containing two hundred Eighty three acres, Resurveyed as afore sd the 3^d day of the 4th month Año: Dñy: 1715.
