These are therefor in the Proprietarys name to will and require thee fforthwith to Survey or Cause to be Surveyed unto him The said numb<sup>r</sup> of acres in the County aforesaid where not already taken up according to the Method of Towneships appointed by the Govern<sup>r</sup>, he Seating and Improveing the Same Within Six months after the Date of Survey, and make returne hereof to the Secretarys Office.
