



Province of Pensilvania and Counties Annexed.

At the Request of Thomas Dewer That I would grant him a
Resurvey on a Tract of Land Situate in the County of Bucks
between the Land that was formerly John Luffs and that of
Ann Milkum laid out to Jeffrey Hawkins for about three hundred
Acres. These are to require thee forthwith to Resurvey or cause to
be resurveyd the Said Tract according to the first Bounds and
Lines of the former Survey, and make Returns thereof into
my Secretaries Office, Given under my Hand and Seal at
Philadelphia the 12th day of ye 8th Moth 1700.
