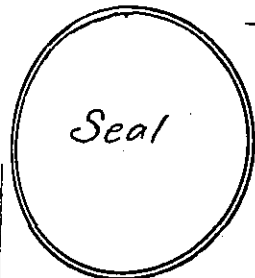

By the Commission<sup>rs</sup> of Property

Whereas the Propriet<sup>rs</sup> by his Warr<sup>t</sup> under his hand & Seal dated 27<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>mo</sup> 1700 did Grant unto Tobias Dymock a Resurvey on a Certain Tract of Land near Meshamineh Creek in the County of Bucks laid out for 250 Acres to Nath<sup>l</sup> Hardin in part of his Purchase of 500 Acres: Also a warr<sup>t</sup> under his hand & Seal of the Same date for taking up the remaining 250 Acres: But Whereas upon the Execution of the S<sup>d</sup> first Warr<sup>t</sup> there is found in the Said Tract 30 Acres of Overplus to be allowed out of the S<sup>d</sup> 250 Acres. These therefore are to require thee to Survey and lay out to the S<sup>d</sup> Tobias Dymock and Sarah his Wife Relict of the S<sup>d</sup> Nathan<sup>l</sup> Hardin Two hundred and Twenty Acres only in lieu of the afores<sup>d</sup> last 250 Acres (hereby revoking the S<sup>d</sup> last Warr<sup>t</sup>) of Land that has not been already taken up nor is concealed nor Seated by the Indians to be laid out according to the Method of Townships appointed, and make Returns into the Gen<sup>l</sup> Surveyors Office at Philad<sup>la</sup> where this Warr<sup>t</sup> is to remain and a copy thereof to be delvd to thee, Certified by ye Secretary. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province

at Philad<sup>la</sup> 18<sup>th</sup> of ye 3<sup>d</sup> Mo<sup>th</sup> 1703.
