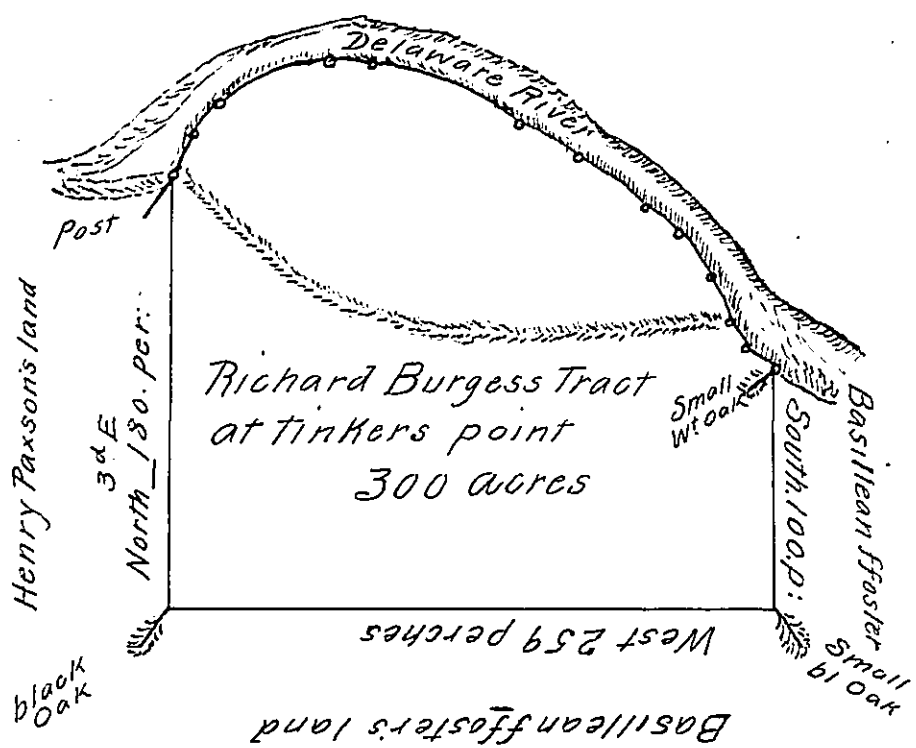

By virtue of a general Warrant from the Proprietaries Comm^{rs} to me directed dated the 5th /^{11th} mo: 1702 to Resurvey all such Tracts and parcels of Land within the County of Bucks as may be reasonably Suspected to have been unduely Surveyed when first taken up and have not yet been rectified. Resurveyed a certaine Tract of Land in Soulbury Township in the Said County formerly laid out to Richard Burgess beginning at a Small White Oak by the River Delaware at Basilean ffoster's Corner, Thence by the Said ffosters line South One hundred perches to a Small black Oak, Then West by the Same two hundred fifty nine perches to a black oak, Then by land laid out to Hen: Paxson North ^{3^d E} One hundred and Eighty perches to ~~the~~ ^{a Post} by the Said River, Then down the Several Courses of the Same to the place of beginning Containing 300 acres. Resurveyed the 29th /^{4th} mo 1703
